Mr. Reinhold P. O. Reuterswärd has been appointed Vice Consul to the Consulate and has now assumed his duties here.


The First Chancellor at the Consulate, Mr. G. E. Elowson, has been given the rank of Vice Consul.

Later I shall have the honor to send you copies of the exequatur.





privileges, powers and privileges as are allowed to the Consuls of the most
favored Nations in the United States.

In testimony whereof, I have caused these Letters to be made Patent, and the Seal of the
United States to be hereunto affixed.

Done, at the City of Washington, this thirtieth day of November,
in the year of our Lord, one thousand nine hundred, and forty-three, and of the
Independence of the United States of America, the one hundred, and sixty-eight.

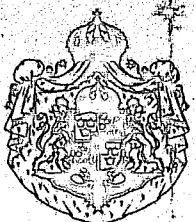
