

PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS, it is well that we remember the infamous Japanese attack at Pearl Harbor on December 7, 1941, and

WHEREAS, it is well that we remember that only the courage of those who fought and died there, and at the other points of attack, saved our homes from invasion,

NOW THEREFORE, I, EDWARD J. THYE, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim

December 7, 1943,

as

REMEMBER PEARL HARBOR DAY

in Minnesota and urge all to increase every war effort that our heritage may be safe from any attack and the invader crushed into defeat and unconditional surrender.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, I have hereunto set my hand and caused the Great Seal of the State of Minnesota to be affixed at the State Capitol in St. Paul, this 6th day of December, 1943.
