We, the undersigned, inspectors, duly appointed and qualified, do hereby certify, that an election for the determination for or against the incorporation of the Village of Flensburg was held on the 14th day of June 1911, and that we did preside and act as inspectors at the election, being the same time and place specified in the notice of election, and that we have canvassed the ballots cast at said election; that the total number of votes cast were 38; and that the number of votes cast in favor of said proposition and incorporation were 30, and that the number of votes cast against said proposition and incorporation were 7, and that one ballot did not indicate the intention of the voter, either way.
