Nelson of Preckenridge, Minnesota, as Special Assistant Attorney General for the Division of Came and Fish to assist in the defense of an action laid in the County of Wilkin, Pixteenth J, dicial District, entitled "E. Said appointment shall commence forthwith and continue until the final disposition of said action, subject to termination otherwise at the pleasure of the Attorney General.
