ORDINANCE NO. 49

AN ORDINANCE EXTENDING THE VILLAGE BOUNDARIES

The Village Council of the Village of Foley do ordain as follows:

Section 1. That the village boundaries of the Village of Foley are hereby extended so as to include the following described unplatted land, abutting upon said village and of record in the names of Paul Esser and Rose Esser, husband and wife, to-wit:

A tract of land 132 feet in width and 330 feet in length in the extreme northeast corner of Section Thirty-five (35), Township Thirty-seven (37), Range Twenty-nine (29), described by metes and bounds as follows: Commencing at a point 33 feet south and 136 feet west of the northeast corner of said Section 35; thence west 132 feet parallel to the north line of said section; thence south 330 feet and parallel with the east line of said section; thence east 132 feet; thence north 330 feet to the point of beginning.
