

Ordinance Number 129

AN ORDINANCE EXTENDING THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE CITY OF STAPLES AND INCORPORATED TERRITORY THEREIN

The City Council of the City of Staples do ordain as follows:

Section One. Pursuant to a petition duly signed by all the owners of the following described land abutting upon the city limits of the City of Staples, and which land has been platted in lots and blocks, and which land is described as follows, to-wit:

Lots One (1) and Two (2) of Block One (1) of Brannon Addition to Staples, according to the plat thereof now on file and of record in the office of the Register of Deeds of Todd County, Minnesota;

the corporate limits of the City of Staples are hereby extended to include the above described lands within its said limits, and the above described lands shall hereafter be included within the corporate limits of said City of Staples, and shall be a part of said City of Staples, and shall be governed as other lands and territory in said City of Staples are now governed.

Section Two. The City Clerk of the City of Staples is hereby directed to forward a certified copy of this Ordinance to the Register of Deeds of Todd County, Minnesota, and to the Secretary of State of the State of Minnesota.

Section Three. The aforesaid lands and territory shall be annexed to the City of Staples, and this Ordinance shall take effect and be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication.

The above Ordinance was passed at a regular meeting of the City Council of the City of Staples on the 28th day of December, 1943.

Lots One (1) and Two (2) of Block One (1) of Brannon Addition to Staples, according to the plat thereof now on file and of record in the office of the Register of Deeds of Todd County, Minnesota;

the corporate limits of the City of Staples are hereby extended to include the above described lands within its said limits, and the above described lands shall hereafter be included within the corporate limits of said City of Staples, and shall be a part of said City of Staples, and shall be governed as other lands and territory in said City of Staples are now governed.

Section Two. The City Clerk of the City of Staples is hereby directed to forward a certified copy of this Ordinance to the Register of Deeds of Todd County, Minnesota, and to the Secretary of State of the State of Minnesota.

Section Three. The aforesaid lands and territory shall be annexed to the City of Staples, and this Ordinance shall take effect and be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication.
