


P R O C L A M A T I O N

WHEREAS, to enable all absent voters who are in the armed forces of the United States to vote in the elections in 1944 it is necessary to change the date of the primary election and make certain other changes in the election laws.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, EDWARD J. THYE, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby summon the members of the Legislature to convene in extra session on Wednesday, the eighth day of March, 1944, at ten o'clock A. M., at the Capitol in St. Paul, Minnesota.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, I have hereunto set my hand and caused the Great Seal of the State of Minnesota to be affixed at the State Capitol in St. Paul, this 11th day of February, 1944.
