WHEREAS, the last session of the State Legislature established the Netropolitan Airports Commission, created the Department of Aeronautics, passed the Uniform Airports Act in conjunction with the Model Zoning Bill, and the Nineteenth Amendment to the Constitution of our state which allocates the tax on sylation gas into a special fund for the construction and maintenance of airports throughout Minnesota, and

WHEREAS, two thousand war contracts of the Army Air Forces

Material Command, of which 1,300 are prime contracts,

to mark the opening of the first northwest eviation exposition, to keep Minnesota first in aviation and to make Minnesota the air flights crossroad of the world.
