WHEREAS, the second anniversary of the establishment of one of the three major components of the Army Service Forces will be celebrated on Thursday, March 9, 1944, and

WHEREAS, the Army Service Forces have made an outstanding contribution to the successful prosecution of the war and utilized to the largest extent the participation of the public in war activities,

AND, WHEREAS, I, EDWARD J. THIEB, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim

March 9, 1944

as

ARMY SERVICE FORCES DAY

in recognition of the contribution by our citizens to the success of the Army Service Forces in the various units of the Seventh Service Command in Minnesota, and call the attention of Minnesotans to further opportunities of participation in this program and the importance of this occasion during this all out war year.
