The manpower needs of Minnesota Agriculture require the total employment of community farm help resources.

Mr. Paul E. Miller, University of Minnesota School of Agriculture, is hereby appointed Director of Farm Help Mobolization in Minnesota for 1944, serving for this purpose without compensation.

Among his duties shall be the promotion of the registration and training of school youths by means of trade centers and county committees, and he shall encourage townspeople with agricultural experience to work on farms of their choice during vacation periods.
