WHEREAS, The State Central Committee of the ~~Democratic~~ ^{Democratic} Party of Minnesota, a political party as defined by the Election Laws of the State of Minnesota, issued a call dated March 5th, 1944, pursuant to the vote of said State Central Committee at a meeting held at ~~St. Paul~~ ^{Minneapolis}, Minnesota, on said March 5th, 1944, for a convention to be held at the City of Minneapolis, Hennepin County, Minnesota, on the 7th day of April, 1944, at ~~10:00~~ ^{2:00} o'clock ~~A.M.~~ ^{P.M.}, for the purpose of changing the name of the said ~~Democratic~~ ^{Democratic} Party from ~~Democratic~~ ^{Democratic} Party to ~~Democratic~~ ^{Democratic} Farmer-Labor Party, and said State Central Committee at its said meeting authorized the State Chairman of said ~~Democratic~~ ^{Democratic} Party to change the date of said State Convention to some other date, and said State Chairman of said Party did change said date to the 14th day of April, 1944, at the same hour, and widespread publicity was given to said change, and

WHEREAS, This Convention is held in accordance with said call, and upon the date so changed,

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED By this Convention that the name of said ~~Democratic~~ ^{Democratic} Party be and hereby is changed to the ~~Democratic~~ ^{Democratic} Farmer-Labor Party.

CERTIFICATE OF AMENDMENT TO THE
CHARTER OF THE
CITY OF WORTHINGTON

.....

I, H.O. Kragness, Mayor of the City of Worthington in the County of Nobles and State of Minnesota, do hereby certify:

1. That under date of the 3d day of February, 1944, the Board of Freeholders of said City duly submitted to me the following proposed amendments to the Charter of the City of Worthington, to-wit:

Amendment No. 1

That Section 39 of said Charter be amended to read as follows:-

"Sec. 39. The Assessor must be a resident and elector in the city for at least two (2) years immediately preceeding his appointment and shall be appointed for a two (2) year term commencing on the first secular day of January in each odd numbered year. He shall by and with the consent and approval of the Council appoint such deputies as may be required to enable him to properly perform the duties of his office, and he may discharge such deputies at will. He shall be appointed in December of the even numbered years.

The term of the assessor and his deputies who may be in office at the time this amendment takes effect shall expire on the first secular day of January, 1945."

Amendment No. 2

That Section 53 be amended to read as follows:-

"Sec. 53. The Council shall appoint three residents and electors of said City to act as Park Commissioners, such appointment being in the manner and for the term as follows, to-wit: At the Annual Meeting in the year 1945, the Council shall appoint one commissioner for a one (1) year term, one Commissioner for a two (2) year term and one commissioner for a three (3) year term. Thereafter and as the term of office of each commissioner expires the Council shall appoint each commissioner for a three (3) year term. The Commissioners shall have such powers and perform such duties as the Council may direct, and shall receive such compensation as the Council may determine."
