


2. That pursuant to the Constitution and Laws of said State, said proposed amendments were published once a week for four weeks in the Worthington/^{Daily}Globe, a newspaper of general circulation in said City, and all other steps required by Law were duly taken to bring the said proposed amendment to a vote of the electors of said City.

3. That said proposed amendments were duly submitted for adoption or rejection of the electors of said City at the election held on the 4th day of April, 1944.

4. That from the official canvass of the votes cast at the said election for and against the aforesaid proposed amendment, made in conformity with the law, it appears that more than three-fifths of all electors voting at such election voted for the adoption of such proposed amendments.

5. That this Certificate is made by me by virtue of the authority vested in me as Mayor of the City of Worthington and in compliance with law, and to certify that aforesaid proposed Amendments to the Charter of said City have been duly ratified and adopted as prescribed by the Constitution and Laws of the State.
