Statement by the State
Soil Conservation
Committee

TO ALL TO WHOM THESE PRESENTS SHALL COME, GREETINGS:

Be it known that on the 8th day of February, 1944, a petition for the organization of the Sherburne County Soil Conservation District, signed by more than 25 land occupiers was duly filed in the Office of the State Soil Conservation Committee:

That on the 8th day of March, 1944, at Zimmerman; and on the 8th day of March, 1944, at Becker, public hearing was held after due notice of the said hearing had been given as required by law;

That on the 10 day of March, 1944, the State Soil Conservation Committee did duly determine that there is need in the interest of the public health, safety and welfare, for a soil conservation district to function in the proposed territory and did define the boundaries thereof;

That thereafter due notice was given of a referendum to be held within the territory so defined by the Committee on the question of the creation of the said district;

That the said referendum was held within the said defined boundaries on the 30th day of March, 1944;

That the result of the said referendum showed that a majority of the votes cast in the said referendum were in favor of the creation of the said district;

That thereafter on the 6th day of April, 1944, the State Soil Conservation Committee did duly determine that the operation of the said district is administratively practicable and feasible;

That the boundaries of the said district were defined by the State Soil Conservation Committee as follows:

All of the County of Sherburne.

There shall be exempted from the land bounded by the above described boundaries all lands used exclusively for religious, school or burial purposes; all parts and parcels of lands in cities, towns and villages which lands are used principally for residential purposes or business purposes other than farming; and all lands in rural or urban areas of three acres or less.



CERTIFICATE OF DUE ORGANIZATION OF THE SHERBURNE COUNTY SOLL CONSERVATION DISTRICT.

TO ALL TO WHOM THESE PRESENTS SHALL COME, GREETING:

WHEREAS, JOE WEIS, ROUTE I, ST. CLOUD, MINN., AND EDWARD SCHWARTZ, ZIMMERHAN, HINN., THE DULY APPOINTED SUPERVISORS OF THE SHERBURNE COUNTY SOIL CONSERVATION DISTRICT, ACTING PURSUANT TO THE MINNESOTA SOIL CONSERVATION DISTRICTS LAW, LAWS OF MINNESOTA FOR 1937, CHAPTER 441, APPROVED APRIL 26, 1937, AND LAWS OF MINNESOTA 1943, CHAPTER 274, APPROVED APRIL 2, 1943, HAVE FILED IN THIS OFFICE AN APPLICATION, SUB-SCRIBED AND SWORN TO BY EACH OF THEM BEFORE AN OFFICER AUTH-ORIZED BY LAW TO TAKE AND CENTIFY OATHS, SETTING FORTH: (I) THAT A PETITION FOR THE CREATION OF THE DISTRICT WAS FILED WITH THE STATE SOIL CONSERVATION COMMITTEE, PURSUANT TO THE PROVISIONS OF THE STATE SOIL CONSERVATION DISTRICTS LAW, AND THE PROCEEDINGS SPECIFIED IN SAID ACT WERE TAKEN PURSUANT TO SUCH PETITION, THAT SAID APPLICATION WAS FILED IN ORDER TO COMPLETE THE ORGANIZATION OF THE DISTRICT AS A GOVERNMENTAL SUBDIVISION AND A PUBLIC BODY, CORPORATE AND POLITIC, AND THAT THE STATE COMMITTEE HAS APPOINTED THEM AS SUPERVISORS: (2) THE NAME AND OFFICIAL RESIDENCE OF THE DISTRICT SUPERVI-SORB, TOGETHER WITH A CERTIFIED COPY OF THE APPOINTMENTS EVIDENCING THEIR RIGHT TO OFFICE; (3) THEIR TERM OF OFFICE; (4) THE NAME WHICH IS PROPOSED FOR THE DISTRICT; AND (5) THE LOCATION OF THE PRINCIPAL OFFICE OF THE SUPERVISORS OF THE DISTRICT; AND

WHEREAS, A STATEMENT BY THE STATE CONSERVATION COMMITTEE, ACCOMPANYING THE ABOVE-MENTIONED APPLICATION, HAS BEEN FILED IN THIS OFFICE, SETTING FORTH THAT A PETITION FOR THE CREATION OF THE SHERBURNE COUNTY SOIL CONSERVATION DISTRICT WAS FILED WITH THE STATE SOIL CONSERVATION COMMITTEE; THAT, AFTER DUE NOTICE, A HEARING WAS HELD, AND THE COUMITTEE DULY DETERMINED THAT THERE IS NEED, IN THE INTEREST OF PUBLIC HEALTH, SAFETY AND WELFARE, FOR A SOIL CONSERVATION DISTRICT TO FUNCTION IN THE PROPOSED PERRITORY, AND THAT THE COMMITTEE DEFINED THE BOUNDARIES THEREOF; THAT THEN, AFTER DUE NOTICE, A REFERENDUM WAS HELD ON THE QUESTION OF THE CREATION OF SAID DISTRICT, AND THE RESULTS OF SAID REFERENDUM SHOWED A MAJORITY OF THE VOTES CAST TO BE IN FAVOR OF THE CREATION OF SAID DISTRICT; AND THAT THEREAFTER THE COMMITTEE DID DULY DETER-MINE THAT THE OPERATION OF THE PROPOSED DISTRICT IS ADMIN-ISTRATIVELY PRACTICABLE AND FEASIBLE. SAID REFERENDUM ALSO SET FORTH THE BOUNDARIES OF THE DISTRICT AS DEFINED BY THE STATE COMMITTEE.
