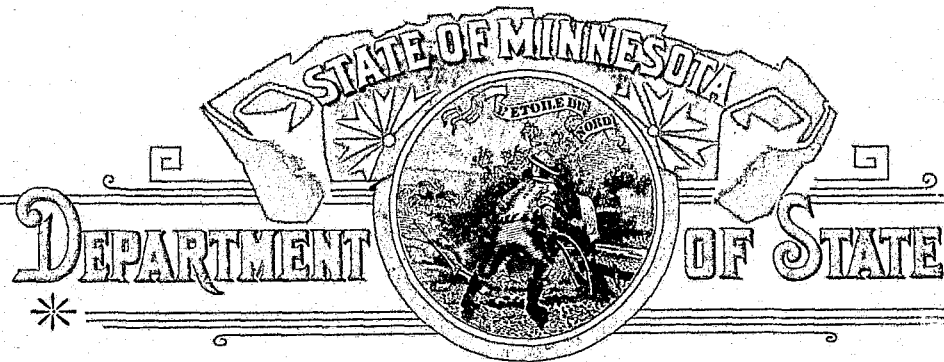

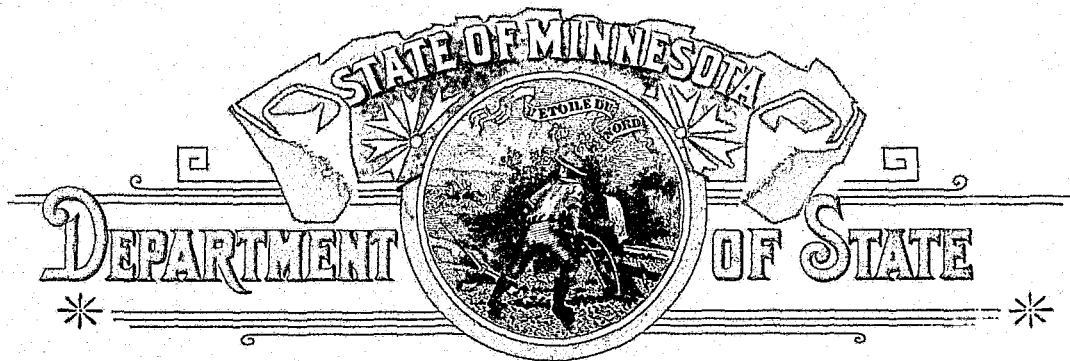

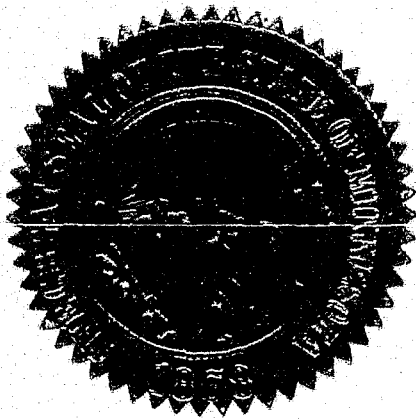
WHEREAS, A STATEMENT BY THE STATE CONSERVATION COMMITTEE,

Be it known that on the 8th day of February, 1944, a petition for the organization of the West Otter Tail Soil Conservation District, signed by more than 25 land occupiers was duly filed in the Office of the State Soil Conservation Committee:

That on the 24th day of February, 1944, at Fergus Falls, public hearing was held after due notice of the said hearing had been given as required by law;

That on the 10th day of March, 1944, the State Soil Conservation Committee did duly determine that there is need in the interest of the public health, safety and welfare, for a soil conservation district to function in the proposed territory and did define the boundaries thereof;

That thereafter due notice was given of a referendum to be held within the territory so defined by the Committee on the question of the creation of the said district;
