WHEREAS, it is recognized that today food is the number one weapon of war, and

WHEREAS, it is further recognized that, despite tremendous increases in food production, demands upon the nations total supply by our armed forces, our allies, and the liberated peoples have grown proportionately, and

WHEREAS, winning on the food front of the war depends on making the best possible use of food at home by sharing and playing square with that which is available, and

WHEREAS, during the coming weeks retail grocery stores throughout our state will feature "No-Point -- Low Point Foods" and display colorful material suggesting the use of the more abundant foods,

NOW, THEREFORE, I, EDWARD J. THYE, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the week of

April 30 - May 6, 1944,

as

FOOD FIGHTS FOR FREEDOM WEEK

and ask consumers to buy the more plentiful foods when shopping, and to order them when dining in hotels, restaurants and other public eating establishments.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, I have hereunto set my hand and caused the Great Seal of the State of Minnesota to be affixed at the State Capitol in St. Paul, this 24th day of April, 1944.
