PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS, children can best be armed against the destructive force of war time excitements, fears and hates by a home environment surcharged with religious faith and good-will, and

WHEREAS, competent citizenship for tomorrow will best be produced by homes in which religious values are paramount, and

WHEREAS, National Family Week emphasizes the spiritual foundations and resources of the family,

NOW, THEREFORE, I, EDWARD J. THYE, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim

May 7 - 14, 1944

as

FAMILY WEEK

in Minnesota and enjoin the attention of the whole community to its responsibility for safeguarding family life and protecting the home against war time hazards.
