PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO THE HOME CHARTER FOR THE CITY OF TWO HARBORS, LAKE COUNTY, MINNESOTA, TO BE SUBMITTED BY THE CHARTER COMMISSION TO THE VOTERS OF THE SAID CITY AT THE REGULAR ELECTION TO BE HELD ON THE 17th DAY OF MARCH 1925.

PROPOSED AMENDMENT.

That Section 14 of Chapter 2 of the City Charter be amended to read as follows:

Section 14. The salary of the Mayor of said City shall be One Hundred Fifty Dollars (\$150.00) per year, and the salary of each Alderman shall be Three Dollars (\$3.00) per meeting for each meeting actually attended by such Alderman, not exceeding however the sum of One Hundred Fifty Dollars (\$150.00) in any one year; the salaries of all other officers and employes shall be fixed by resolution passed by a majority vote of all the members of the City Council, and the salaries of the officers and employes shall be paid out of the treasury of the City.
