PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS, dairy products are essential to the maintenance of human health and efficiency, both on the fighting front and on the home front, and

WHEREAS, dairy farmers and the entire dairy industry are exerting every possible means of producing the maximum amounts of these products, and

WHEREAS, due to shortages of dairy products of all kinds, there is great need of better understanding of the importance and the use of these products to the end that maximum food values may be obtained from such supplies as are available, and

WHEREAS, Minnesota is the largest butter producing state in the Nation and a leader in the production of other dairy products, large quantities of which are now contributing to the winning of the war,

NOW, THEREFORE, I, EDWARD J. THYE, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the month of

J U N E

as

DAIRY MONTH

throughout the State of Minnesota, and request the citizens of our State to join me publicly in recognizing the efforts of this industry and its products as being vital to Victory.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, I have hereunto set my hand and caused the Great Seal of the State of Minnesota to be affixed at the State Capitol in St. Paul this 1st day of June, 1944.
