

ORDINANCE NO. 93.

An Ordinance, Extending the boundary lines of said Village of Le Center, Minnesota, so as to include in said Village, the lands below and in this ordinance described, and making said lands a part of said Village.

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The Village Council of Le Center, Minnesota, does ordain, as follows:

1.

That the following piece of land, lying adjacent to and joining said Village on the north, viz; commencing at a point at the intersection of Park Ave., formerly Le Sueur street, with Solberg Ave, said Village, which point lies on the north corporation line, and is 33 feet east and 33 feet north of the northeast corner of Block Four, Solberg's addition to Le Center, assuming that both the east and north lines of said block four, were projected, as a point of commencement.

Thence to run north 200 feet; thence to run west 330 feet, more or less, to a point 200 feet north of a point in the north corporation line, said Village, which point is in the middle of the intersection of said Solberg Ave, and Lexington streets, in said Village; thence to run to said last mentioned point, a distance of 200 feet; more or less, and thence running east, along said north corporation line said Village to point of commencement, excepting however a piece 30 by 50 feet, deeded to M. V. Gas Co, are hereby included within said Village.

2.

The Boundary lines of said Village of Le Center, Minnesota, are hereby enlarged to cover said above lands, together with, the extensions of Solberg Ave, Park Ave and Lexington streets, and any adjoining and included streets and alleys.

3.

This ordinance shall take effect from and after its passage and publication.
