W H E R E A S , the people of China celebrate the 33rd birthday of their Republic on October 10, 1944, and
W H E R E A S , the Chinese, allied with the United Nations in the war on aggressors and oppression, are in desperate need of assistance of every kind, and
W H E R E A S , the people of Minnesota are determined to give all aid possible in the National movement for the relief of China,

NOW, THEREFORE, I, EDWARD J. THYE, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim

October 10, 1944,

as

REPUBLIC OF CHINA DAY

in honor of a courageous, fighting ally and in relief of her destitute, suffering people.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, I have hereunto set my hand and caused the Great Seal of the State of Minnesota to be affixed at the State Capitol in St. Paul this 26th day of September, 1944.
