WRIT AND PROCLAMATION OF SPECIAL ELECTION
TO FILL VACANCY IN THE OFFICE OF
STATE REPRESENTATIVE FROM THE
FIFTIETH REPRESENTATIVE DISTRICT

To the People of the State of Minnesota, and particularly of the
Fiftieth Representative District of said State; to the Secretary
of State of the State of Minnesota; to the County Auditor of
the County of Ottertail of said State; to all Election Officials
of said Fiftieth Representative District and of the several
Election Districts therein; and to all Others Whom it May Concern -
GREETING:


WHEREAS a vacancy will exist in the office of state representative
in the legislature from the Fiftieth Representative District of the
State of Minnesota, for the term commencing January 2, 1945, caused by
the death of the Honorable Walter Wellbrook, who was duly elected as
said representative at the last general election; and

WHEREAS there will be occasion at the regular session of
the state legislature convening January 2, 1945, for the person elected
to fill said vacancy to exercise the functions of said office immediately
after his election;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Edward J. Thye, as Governor of the State of
Minnesota, acting under authority and direction of Section 17 of Article IV
of the Constitution of this state and the statutes in such case provided,
do hereby direct that a special election to fill said vacancy be held in
said district on Wednesday, the 27th day of December, 1944, that a special
primary election for the nomination of candidates for said vacancy be held
in said district on Wednesday, the 20th day of December, 1944, that the
affidavits of candidates for nomination at said primary be filed not later
than the seventh day before said primary, to-wit, not later than Wednesday,
the 13th day of December, 1944, that notices of said primary and election
be given, that candidates be nominated, that said primary and election

be held, and that all things pertaining thereto be done as provided
by law.


