PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS, the price ceilings are essential to the wartime welfare of the citizens of Minnesota and of the merchants who serve them,

WHEREAS, as during the First World War, military victories will not immediately remove the dangers of disastrous inflation, and

WHEREAS, for some time to come we will face inflationary dangers that could rapidly destroy from within the very security our Armed Forces are fighting to protect,

NOW, THEREFORE, I, EDWARD J. THYE, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby invoke each citizen to participate wholeheartedly in the Minnesota GROCER-CONSUMER ANTI-INFLATION CAMPAIGN by frank and friendly adherence to our ceiling price program.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, I have hereunto set my hand and caused the Great Seal of the State of Minnesota to be affixed at the State Capitol in St. Paul this 30th day of November, 1944.
