the House of Representatives of the State of Minnesota is the sole and final judge of the election returns and as to which of said candidates is entitled to an election certificate.

That the said contestee has served demand upon the Clerk of District Court of Hennepin County, Minnesota to forward all of the proceedings in said election contest to the speaker of the House of Representatives and that the Clerk of District Court

YOU ARE FURTHER NOTIFIED that on the 28th day of December, 1944 the District Court of Hennepin County issued an order enjoining and restraining the said Joseph M.
