

PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS, Millions of people all over the world today look for signs that the world is moving toward a realization of man's eternal dream of that unity and brotherhood of man without which there can be no enduring peace, and

WHEREAS, men of all creeds and every race fight together to destroy the enemies of democracy and make possible a world in which different peoples may live together in brotherhood and harmony,

NOW, THEREFORE, I, EDWARD J. THYE, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim

February 18 - 25, 1945

as

BROTHERHOOD WEEK

in Minnesota, and urge all Minnesotans to join with the National Conference of Christians and Jews in observance of this Week, and dedicate themselves perpetually to the task of making secure at home the principle for which our men are fighting abroad - the principle that all of our people, of whatever race, creed or color, have equality of opportunity to live together in brotherhood and harmony.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, I have hereunto set my hand and caused the Great Seal of the State of Minnesota to be affixed at the State Capitol in St. Paul this 29th day of January, 1945.
