


KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That I, J. A. A. Burnquist, Attorney General of the State of Minnesota, by virtue of the authority vested in me by statute, and particularly by authority of Section 114, Mason's Minnesota Statutes of 1927, and the written request of the Commissioner of Taxation, do hereby constitute and appoint David W. Lewis of Saint Paul, Minnesota, as Assistant Attorney General for the Department of Taxation, for the period commencing March 14, 1945, and to serve at the pleasure of the Attorney General or until this commission shall be revoked or otherwise terminated in accordance with law; and, on the recommendation of said department, I hereby fix the compensation of said David W. Lewis as such Assistant Attorney General for the Department of Taxation in the amount now or hereafter fixed by statute for Assistant Attorneys General to be paid from the appropriations made for the Department of Taxation.

IN TESTIMONY WHEREOF I have hereunto set my hand at St. Paul, Minnesota, this 14th day of March, 1945.


