

Ordinance No. 28

An ordinance annexing certain lands to the Village of Waubun, Mahon County Minnesota.

The Village Council of the Village of Waubun do ordain as follows:

That the following described tract of land abutting upon the Village of Waubun described as follows:

A tract of land in Section Twenty-Five (25), Township One Hundred Forty-Three (143), Range Forty-Two (42) described as follows, viz: Beginning at the point of intersection of the east line of the right of way of the Soo Line Railway with the north line of Section Twenty-Five (25), Township One Hundred Forty-Three (143), Range Forty Two (42), thence running east along said Section line One Hundred (100) feet, thence running south One Hundred Forty (140) feet, thence running west to the east line of the right of way of the Soo Line Railway, thence running in a northwesterly direction to the place of beginning, being in the North Half of the Northwest Quarter (NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of NW $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section Twenty-Five (25), Township One Hundred Forty-Three (143), Range Forty-Two (42).

and the same is hereby annexed to such Village as effectually as if it had originally been a part thereof.

This ordinance shall take effect upon its publication and a certified copy has been filed with the County Auditor and with the Secretary of the State of Minnesota.
