An ordinance annexing certain Lots and Blocks

The village council of the village of Mayer
do ordain as follows:

Section 1. That the following described Lots,
To. One, Two, Three, Four, Five, Six, Eleven and Twelve (1, 2, 3,
4, 5, 10, 11, and 12) Block, No. One (1), of Sawyer's first
(1st) Addition to the village of Mayer, also, all of
Block No. Three (3) Sawyer's second (2nd) Addition to
the village of Mayer, including all streets and alleys
adjoining, abutting upon the incorporated village of
Mayer, be and the same are hereby annexed to such village
and shall become a part of such village as effectually
as if they had been originally a part thereof.
