

PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS, throughout the world the sturdy men and women of the United Nations are courageously fighting the battles for freedom, security, and justice; and

WHEREAS, the United Nations are pledged to a program of enduring peace on a universal basis; and

WHEREAS, the representatives of four great powers assembled in conference at Dumbarton Oaks drafted and adopted proposals which present a foundation for the organization and maintenance of a permanent peace structure, and

WHEREAS, it is desirable that the people of America study the Dumbarton Oaks proposals and participate in public discussions concerning them prior to the United Nations Conference at San Francisco in order that there may be a thorough understanding of their meaning and significance,

NOW, THEREFORE, I, EDWARD J. THYE, Governor of the State of Minnesota, hereby proclaim the period from

April 16 - 22, 1945
inclusive

as

DUMBARTON OAKS WEEK

in Minnesota, and I urge the people of the State to join in the public discussions of these proposals and to conclude the week on Sunday, April 22, with devotional services in churches, with prayers for the success of the coming conference on peace that is to be held at San Francisco.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, I have hereunto set my hand and caused the Great Seal of the State of Minnesota to be affixed at the State Capitol in St. Paul, this 9th day of April, 1945.
