PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS, eighty-seven years ago, on May 11, 1858, Minnesota
was admitted to the Union as a state, and

WHEREAS, our North Star State of 10,000 lakes, of rich,
fertile and beautiful lands, great cities and busy
towns, is our honored and beloved homeland, and

WHEREAS, many of our sons and daughters have followed her
proud flag to the battlefields of the world and
contributed immeasurably to the successful prosecution
of the war,

NOW, THEREFORE, I, EDWARD J. THYE, Governor of the State of Minnesota,
do hereby proclaim

May 11, 1945

as

STATE DAY

and I call upon our citizens to thank God for Minnesota, and to honor
and pray for those who are serving in the armed forces.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, I have here-
unto set my hand and caused the
Great Seal of the State of Minne-
sota to be affixed at the State
Capitol in St. Paul this 11th day
of May, 1945.
