WHEREAS, This Board, for the reasons hereinabove cited and for the convenience of public officials, determines that it will be for the best interests of the people of St. Louis County and said Township to officially dissolve the Township of Fern.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, That this Board does hereby determine that by reason of the vote of the people in said Township on Narch 13, 1945, and by the reason that the assessed valuation of said Township as of May 1, 1944, of real estate and personal property was \$4,023.00, and by the further reason that the state or federal government has acquired title to the real estate of said Township in excess of fifty per cent, that it will be for the best interests of the public that said Township be dissolved and said Township is hereby declared dissolved and terminated as a civil Township, pursuant to Section 368.47, Minnesota Statutes, 1941.

RESOLVED FURTHER, That any funds standing to the credit of said Township of Fern on the books of the County Auditor and in the County treasury are hereby directed to be apportioned as provided by Law.

RESOLVED FURTHER, That the County Auditor is forthwith directed to submit a certified copy of this resolution to the Secretary of State, as required by Law.
