PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS, the many millions of Victory Gardens throughout the country have contributed much to the nation's food supply, and

WHEREAS, our food needs for 1945 will probably be greater than in any twelve month period since the war started, and

WHEREAS, the President of the United States has requested that every family with suitable garden space available either at home or in vacant lots, employes or community gardens, have a Victory Garden in 1945,

NOW, THEREFORE, I, EDWARD J. THYE, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the week of

April 29 through May 6, 1945

as

VICTORY GARDEN WEEK

in Minnesota, and call upon the citizens of the State to have Victory Gardens, wherever possible, and to cooperate to the fullest extent in this vital and patriotic program.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, I have hereunto set my hand and caused the Great Seal of the State of Minnesota to be affixed at the State Capitol in St. Paul, this 27th day of April, 1945.
