W H E R E A S, while today we lag behind neighboring states in War Bond purchases during this Seventh War Loan, we are resolved to regain our rightful leadership among the states, and

W H E R E A S, Minnesota never has failed in support of every phase of this War and once more its citizens will demonstrate their patriotism and their thrift by turning Flag Day into visual evidence that they are backing our fighting men and women by their War Bonds,

NOW, THEREFORE, I, EDWARD J. THYE, Governor of the State of Minnesota do hereby proclaim

Thursday, June 14, 1945

as

MINNESOTA E DAY AND FLAG DAY

and to commemorate this day I urge every Minnesota citizen to earn his own personal E.Award by the increased purchase of War Bonds. I further urge that by these purchases we rededicate our efforts towards early and final victory.
