- WHEREAS, in previous War Loan Drives our state has done its share and more, and
- WHEREAS, while today we lag behind neighboring states in Wer Bond purchases during this Seventh War Loan, we are resolved to regain our rightful leadership among the states, and
- W H E H E A S. Minnesota never has failed in support of every bhase of this War and once more its citizens will despiratrate their patriotism and their thrift by turning Fing Day into visual evidence that they are backing our fighting mon and women by their War Bonds.
