KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That I, J. A. A. Burnquist, Attorney General of the State of Minnesota, by virtue of the authority vested in me by law and particularly by Mason's Minnesota Statutes 1927, Section 114, and upon the request of Chester S. Wilson, Commissioner of Conservation, do hereby constitute and appoint Mandt Torrison of Saint Paul, Minnesota, as Special Assistant Attorney General to prosecute to completion pending litigation of which he has had charge, including some important test cases requiring Supreme Court decisions, and to assist the new counsel to be appointed in disposing of pending office work, attending water level hearings and other proceedings which are in prospect, and otherwise becoming familiar with their duties. Said appointment shall commence forthwith, and said appointee shall serve at the pleasure of the Attorney General, or until this commission shall be revoked or otherwise terminated in accordance with law. The compensation for his services shall be paid from funds appropriated to the Department of Conservation and available for that purpose and shall be subject to the approval of the Attorney General.
