We, E. Steffensen, President, of the
Village Council, and H. F. Wittmer, Village Recorder of the
Village of Kiester, in said County of Faribault and State of
Minnesota, do hereby certify that in pursuance and in accordance
with a Petition signed by more than fifty resident voters, duly
presented to the Village Council, and in pursuance to a Resolution
passed by the said Village Council, and due notice given by the
publication and posting thereof, as provided by law, a special
election was held in said Village on the 31st day of October,
1911, to vote upon the following question, to-wit: "Shall the
Village of Kiester, Faribault County, Minnesota, separate for
all purposes from the Township of Kiester, Faribault County,
Minnesota, and become a separate election and assessment district."
A total of fifty-eight ballots were cast upon the question, of
which fifty-seven were in favor of said question and one vote
was against the said question, and that the said fifty-seven
ballots so cast is a majority of the electors casting their ballots
upon the question at said special election called for that purpose.


