ORDINANCE NO. 168

AN ORDINANCE TO ANNEX CERTAIN ABUTTING TERRITORY TO THE CITY OF WORTHINGTON.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WORTHINGTON, DO ORDAIN:

NOW WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 1843 et seq of Mason*s Minnesota Statutes of 1927, being Section 413.14 of Minnesota Statutes for 1941, a majority of the owners of the property hereinafter described, have petitioned the City Council of the City of Worthington to have such property annexed to said City;

AND WHEREAS, it is desired that said territory become a part of said City of Worthington, the same as if it had been originally a part thereof;
