WHEREAS, our reunited families, our readapted industrial system, and our reorganized communities will be confronted with many difficult peace time problems, and


WHEREAS, secure foundations can be laid for the future only as men and women commit their plans and purposes to the eternal principles of religious faith and themselves to a loving and understanding God,


