

ORDINANCE NUMBER 38

An Ordinance annexing certain adjacent and abutting Real property to the Village of Rockford.

That said corporation during all said times was and now is the proprietor, printer and publisher of the newspaper known as "Minneapolis Star Journal," which was during all said times and still is a daily newspaper printed and published in the city of Minneapolis, in the county of Hennepin and state of Minnesota.

That during all the times aforesaid said newspaper was qualified as a medium of official and legal publications as required by Section 1, Chapter 128, Session Laws of Minnesota, 1939, and Section 4, Chapter 484, Session Laws of Minnesota, 1921, and that it has complied with all the requirements that constitute a legal newspaper, as defined in said Sections to wit: that for more than one year last past from the

date of the first publication of said .....advertisement....said newspaper has

1. Been printed in the English language from its known office of publication within the city from which it purports to be issued, and in newspaper form at and in column sheet form equivalent in space to at least 450 running inches of single column two inches wide.
2. Been issued six days each week (to wit, on each and every day of the week except Sunday) from a known office established in such place for such publication and employing skilled workmen and the necessary material for preparing and printing the same. The press work on that part of the newspaper devoted to local news of interest to the community which it purports to serve is done in its known office of publication.
3. Contained general and local news, comment and miscellany, not wholly duplicating any other publication and has not been entirely made of patents, plate matter and advertisements, or any or either of them. Twenty-five per cent of its news columns have been devoted to local news of interest to the community which it purports to serve.
4. Been circulated in and near its place of publication to the extent of at least 240 copies regularly delivered to paying subscribers and has had entry as second class matter in its local post office.
5. Complied with all the foregoing conditions for at least one year last past.

That prior to the date of the first publication of said ...advertisement.... a duly qualified officer of said corporation having knowledge of the facts, filed with the County Auditor of said county of Hennepin, state of Minnesota, an affidavit showing the name and location of said newspaper and the existence of conditions constituting its qualifications as a legal newspaper as required and set forth in Section 1 of Chapter 128, Session Laws, Minnesota, 1939.
