A Proclamation of Thanksgiving

Festivals of Thanksgiving in days of good fortune and in times of plenty have become a universal custom, but the American tradition of Thanksgiving Day has proved to intensify and heighten the national expression of a sentiment as old as mankind.

In Pilgrim days observed the first Thanksgiving Day on the seashore coast of New England, gave thanks to Almighty God for their deliverance. Those who laid the foundations of this nation more than a century and a half later, that men might have a new legacy of freedom, нарсured civil and religious liberty among the gifts for which they were especially grateful. Each succeeding generation, while mindful of material blessings which have in the United States so abounded, in turn gave thanks for something more precious than those. That men dare by what they believe, what they do.

In proclaiming Thursday, November 22, 1945 as Thanksgiving Day I strongly urge my fellow citizens of Minnesota to emulate the example of other generations of our citizenry who have set this day apart as a day of thanksgiving prayer and thanksgiving to the Author of Liberty and turned to the Holy Scriptures of their respective creeds for suitable expression of their gratitude and for wisdom to guide them in the future, and also as a day of patriotic rededication that the flag of our country so appropriately displayed on public buildings and elsewhere as an expression of our love of country and our faith in the future.

We have been privileged in our time to lay a costly sacrifice upon the altar of our country to preserve the American heritage. Now, in a new day of peace, we look forward with hope to the future, and on this most typical of American holidays, Thanksgiving Day, we may well join in the words of a beloved American song -

American Arias  
God shed his grace on thee  
And crown thy good with brotherhood,  
From sun to shining sea.
