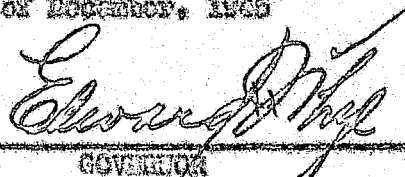
W H E R E A S, the United States Junior Chamber of Commerce is observing its 25th year of service to the nation, and has pledged its future services to the returning veterans:

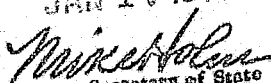
