

ORDINANCE # 48

AN ORDINANCE ANNEXING ABUTING LAND TO VILLAGE LIMITS.

BE IT ORDAINED, ---- by the Common Council of the Village of Richmond, Minnesota, at a legal meeting held on the 25 day of September, 1945, at its regular meeting place in the Village Hall in said Village.

Section I.

Acting upon a petition presented by School District Number Twenty, Stearns County, Minnesota, at a regular meeting held on August 28th, 1945, the Village Council voted to extend the Village Limits to include the following described land, to-wit:

Beginning 366 feet West from the Avon and Richmond County Road at the Southeast corner of the SE $\frac{1}{4}$  of SW $\frac{1}{4}$ , of Section 13, Township 123, Range 31, thence running West 666 feet, thence running North 300 feet, thence running 666 feet East, and thence running South 300 feet to the point of beginning, Stearns County, Minnesota.


Section II.


Section III.


All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.

Passed by the Village Council of Richmond, Minnesota, this 25 day of September, 1945.


