#### RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, Clarence Bjornson and others have filed a petition requesting incorporation of land in the Township of Medo in the County of Blue Earth, and have filed herein a census of the territory sought to be described including 143 persons, and said petition contains more than the legal number of signers thereto.

BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED, that an election for the purpose of determining whether said incorporation should be effected shall be held at the Village of Pemberton in said Medo Township on Tuesday, the 16th day of April 1946, between the hours of 9 o'clock a. m. and 5 o'clock p.m.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that J. T. Swartz, August Bluhm, and John Clausen of said territory sought to be incorporated shall be named as inspectors to act in the capacity of Judges in said election.

We, the undersigned, inspectors appointed by the County Board of Blue Earth County, Minnesota, and residents of the area sought to be incorporated at a special election, do hereby certify that an election was held at the Medo Town Hall in said County on April 16, 1946, between the hours of 9 o'clock a.m. and 5 o'clock p.m. to vote on the question of whether or not the land included in the platted portion of Pemberton in said Medo Township, and lands adjacent thereto as set out in the position for incorporation, should be incorporated into a village to be known as the Village of Pemberton; that we acted as judges of said election which was conducted so far as possible as elections for town officers; that we have canvassed the ballots cast at said election; that 63 votes were cast, with 47 votes being cast in favor of incorporation, and 16 votes being cast in opposition to said incorporation.

We, the undersigned voters in that part of Medo Township in said Blue Earth County, known as Pemberton, and having resided within said territory continuously for a period of at least two years prior to the date hereof, do hereby petition this honorable body to call an election of the voters in the area hereinafter described for the determination of the proposed incorporation of a village to be known as the Village of Pemberton, in accordance with Section 412.02 et seq. of Minnesota Statutes of 1941, and Section 1111 et seq. of Mason's Minnesota Statutes of 1927.

We do further state that a census of the resident population of the area hereinafter described has been taken, and that the number of persons residing in said area is more than one hundred, to wit, is 143, and that said census was taken by Mr. and Mrs. Lyle C. Owan on February 18, 1946.

The area to be included in said proposed Village is as follows, all located in the County of Blue Earth and State of Minnesota, to wit:

Pemberton in the  $S\frac{1}{2}$  of the  $S.W.\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 1, T. 106 N.R. 25 W. Medo Township, Blue Earth Co., Minnesota, according to the plat thereof on file and of record in the office of the Register of Deeds in and for said County and State.

All of the South Half of the Southwest Quarter ( $S\frac{1}{2}$  of  $SW\frac{1}{4}$ ) in Section One (1), Township One Hundred Six (106) North, Range Twenty-five (25) West in said Blue Earth County, not included in the plat of Pemberton as hereinabove described.
