



AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR ANNEXATION OF CERTAIN  
TERRITORY TO THE VILLAGE OF MORNINGSIDE,  
HENNEPIN COUNTY, MINNESOTA.

THE VILLAGE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF MORNINGSIDE  
DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. WHEREAS, the westerly boundary of the Village of Morningside extending from West 44th Street to Morningside Road, which divides the corporate limits of the Village of St. Louis Park and the Village of Morningside between said points, extends in a northerly and southerly direction at an angle to adjacent streets which have been laid out in a northwesterly to southeasterly direction, and as a result the said boundary line intersects the platted lots and buildings thereon at an angle which causes an unsatisfactory division of jurisdiction between the two said villages, and it is deemed in the public interest by the respective Village Councils of said Villages that the boundary between said villages extending from the center line of Morningside Road to the center line of 44th St. be modified so as to be described as follows:

Commencing at a point in the center line of Morningside Road where same intersects with the westerly line of the Southeast Quarter (SE $\frac{1}{4}$ ) of Section Seven (7), Township Twenty-eight (28), Range Twenty-four (24), thence West along the center line of Morningside Road to a point thirty (30) feet North from the Northwest corner of Lot One (1), Block Two (2), Wooddale Heights; thence South to said Northwest corner of said Lot One (1); thence Southeasterly along the southwesterly line of lots One (1), Two (2), Three (3), Four (4), Five (5), Six (6), and Seven (7), Block Two (2), Wooddale Heights, and the same extended to the Southeasterly line of Lot Eighteen (18), Grimes Homestead; thence northeasterly along the southeasterly line of said Lot Eighteen (18) a distance of ten (10) feet; thence southeasterly along a line parallel with the southwesterly line of lots Seventeen (17), Sixteen (16), Fifteen (15) and Fourteen (14), Grimes Homestead, to a point One Hundred Fifty (150) feet southeasterly from the southeasterly line of Lot Fifteen (15), Grimes Homestead; thence southwesterly at right angle twenty-five (25) feet; thence southeasterly along a line parallel with the southwest line of Lot Thirteen (13), Grimes Homestead, to the center line of West 44th Street; thence southwesterly along the center line of West 44th Street to the westerly line of the Southeast Quarter (SE $\frac{1}{4}$ ) of Section Seven (7), Township Twenty-eight (28), Range Twenty-four (24), Hennepin County, Minnesota.

SECTION 2. WHEREAS, the majority of the owners of property in that portion of the Village of St. Louis Park lying East of the above described modified boundary line have filed their petition in writing with the Village Council to have such property annexed to the Village of Morningside, and said property has been platted into lots and is abutting upon the corporate limits of the Village of Morningside, and a similar petition has been filed with the Village Council of St. Louis Park by a majority of the owners of property within that portion of the Village of Morningside lying West of the above described line for annexation to the Village of St. Louis Park:

SECTION 3. There is hereby annexed to the Village of Morningside the foregoing described property situated in the Village of St. Louis Park and more particularly described as follows:

Tract No. 1 - That part of the Northeasterly 150 feet of Lot 15, lying in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 7, Township 28, Range 24, Grimes Homestead.

Tract No. 2 - That part of the Southwesterly 150 feet

of the Northeasterly 250 feet of the Northwesterly 50 feet of Lot 16, lying in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 7, Township 28, Range 24, Grimes Homestead.

Tract No. 3 - That part of the Southeasterly 50 feet of the Southwesterly 130 feet of the Northeasterly 250 feet of lot 16, lying in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 7, Township 28, Range 24, Grimes Homestead.

Tract No. 4 - That part of the Southeasterly 50 feet of the Northeasterly 130 feet of the Southwesterly 280 feet of lot 17, lying Westerly of the East line of SW $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 7, Township 28, Range 24, Grimes Homestead.

Tract No. 5 - That part of the Northwesterly 50 feet of the Northeasterly 130 feet of the Southwesterly 280 feet of lot 17, lying West of the East line of SW $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 7, Township 28, Range 24, Grimes Homestead.

Tract No. 6 - That part of the Southeasterly 45 feet of the Northeasterly 160 feet of lot 18, lying West of the North and South center line of Section 7, Township 28, Range 24, Grimes Homestead.

Tract No. 7 - That part of the Northwesterly 55 feet of the Northeasterly 160 feet of lot 18, lying West of the North and South center line of Section 7, Township 28, Range 24, Grimes Homestead.

Tract No. 8 - Fractional Lot 2, Block 1, Wooddale Heights.

Tract No. 9 - Fractional Lot 3, Block 1, Wooddale Heights.

Tract No. 10 - Fractional Lot 4, Block 1, Wooddale Heights.

Tract No. 11 - Fractional Lot 5, Block 1, Wooddale Heights.

Tract No. 12 - Lot 1, Block 2, Wooddale Heights.

Tract No. 13 - Lot 2, Block 2, Wooddale Heights.

Tract No. 14 - Lot 3, Block 2, Wooddale Heights.

Tract No. 15 - Lot 4, Block 2, Wooddale Heights.

Tract No. 16 - Fractional Lot 5, Block 2, Wooddale Heights.

Tract No. 17 - Fractional Lot 6, Block 2, Wooddale Heights.

Tract No. 18 - Fractional Lot 7, Block 2, Wooddale Heights.

SECTION 4. The Village Council of the Village of Morningside hereby consents to the annexation by the Village Council of the Village of St. Louis Park of the property above referred to which is now within the corporate limits of the Village of Morningside and lying West of the above described proposed modified boundary, provided, however, and on condition that, the Village Council of St. Louis Park shall by ordinance consent to the annexation to the Village of Morningside of the property described in Section 3 hereof and which is now within the corporate limits of the Village of St. Louis Park.

SECTION 5. This ordinance shall take effect from and after January 1, 1946 and after its publication.

A PETITION FOR ANNEXATION, CORPORATELY AND TERRI-  
TORIALLY, WITH THE CITY OF MANKATO, MINNESOTA, OF  
TERRITORY SITUATED IN THE COUNTY OF BLUE EARTH,  
STATE OF MINNESOTA.

TO THE HONORABLE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MANKATO, A MUNICIPAL  
CORPORATION ORGANIZED AND EXISTING UNDER THE LAWS OF THE STATE  
OF MINNESOTA.

We, the undersigned, being more than five (5) of the  
legal voters residing within the hereinafter described territory  
proposed to be annexed, corporately and territorially, with the  
City of Mankato, corporately a municipal corporation organized and  
existing under the laws of the State of Minnesota, hereby petition  
you, the governing body of the said corporate City of Mankato, that  
you call an election for the determination of this proposed  
annexation, corporately and territorially, of the hereinafter  
described territory with the said City of Mankato.

That on the 6th day of April, 1946, your petitioner  
caused to be taken a census of the resident population of said  
territory proposed to be so annexed and found that the same was  
194 in number, the names of the said residents being listed in  
Exhibit A, hereto annexed and hereby made a part hereof.

That the said territory proposed to be so annexed is  
situated in the County of Blue Earth, State of Minnesota, and  
bounded as follows, viz:

Commencing at the point where the extended East boundary  
line of the West one-eighth of the Northeast quarter  
(NE $\frac{1}{4}$ ) of Section seventeen (17), Township one hundred  
eight (108) North, Range twenty six (26) West, meets the  
North boundary line of Rhine Street in the City of  
Mankato, and running from thence East along the extension  
East of the said North boundary line of Rhine Street to  
the point where the extension North of the East boundary  
line of plat entitled, "Second Extension to East Mankato"  
now on file and of record in the office of the Register  
of Deeds in and for said County of Blue Earth, meets the  
same, thence South along said East boundary line of said  
plat to the Southeast corner of said plat, thence West  
along the South boundary line of said plat and continuing  
West along the South boundary line of plat entitled,  
"First Extension to East Mankato", now on file and of  
record in the office of the Register of Deeds in and for  
said County of Blue Earth, to the Northeast corner of  
Block twenty two (22) of said plat entitled, "Second  
Extension to East Mankato", thence South along the East  
boundary line of said Block 22 and continuing along an  
extension of the same to the South boundary line of the
