WHEREAS, A due and lawful petition was received and ordered filed by the Council of the City of Mankato, a municipal corporation organized and existing under the laws of the State of Minnesota, at a regular meeting of the said Council on the 23rd day of April, 1946, petitioning for an election for the determination of a proposed annexation of the said City of Mankato, corporate and territorial, of the following bounded territory, situated in the County of Blue Earth, State of Minnesota, viz:

Commencing at the point where the extended East boundary line of the West one-eighth of the Northeast quarter (NE $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section seventeen (17), Township one hundred eight (108) North, Range twenty six (26) West, meets the North boundary line of Rhine Street in the City of Mankato, and running from thence East along the extension East of the said North boundary line of Rhine Street to the point where the extension North of the East boundary line of plat entitled, "Second Extension to East Mankato", now on file and of record in the office of the Register of Deeds in and for said County of Blue Earth, meets the same, thence South along said East boundary line of said plat to the Southeast corner of said plat, thence West along the South boundary line of said plat and continuing West along the South boundary line of plat entitled, "First Extension to East Mankato", now on file and of record in the office of the Register of Deeds in and for said County of Blue Earth, to the Northeast corner of Block twenty two (22) of said plat entitled, "Second Extension to East Mankato", thence South along the East boundary line of said Block 22 and continuing along an extension of the same to the South boundary line of the public street abutting the South side of said Block 22, thence West along the said South boundary line of said street to the East boundary line of said City of Mankato, and thence North along the said East boundary line of said City to the place of beginning.

WHEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MANKATO, MINNESOTA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That such an election be held in the said territory sought to be annexed to the said City of Mankato.

Section 2. That Eva Hennessey, Peter H. Hansen, and Maude M. Barlow, resident voters of the said territory sought to be annexed, are hereby appointed as the three (3) inspectors, to act as judges of the said election and to conduct the same,

so far as practicable, in accordance with the laws regulating the election by ballot of town officers. Only qualified voters residing within the said territory shall be entitled to vote.

Section 3. That said election shall be held in the private garage of Peter H. Hansen, on Belle Avenue, between Long Street and Hope Street, within the said territory, on the 25th day of May, 1946, between the hours of 9:30 o'clock A. M. and 5:00 o'clock P. M. of that day.

Section 4. That a copy of the said petition with a notice attached thereto, which notice shall set forth the said purpose, the said time and the said place of holding the said election, shall be posted, as provided for by law, in at least three public places within the said territory.
