

PETITION FOR INCORPORATION

VILLAGE OF MAPLEVIEW

The undersigned, being voters who have resided continuously for not less than two years within the Maplevieu Addition to the City of Austin, Minnesota, herewith petition the county board of Mower County, Minnesota to call and conduct an election within said territory for the purpose of determining the proposed incorporation thereof as a village.

1.

The boundaries of said territory proposed to be incorporated are as follows:

Beginning at Northwest (NW) corner of Northeast Quarter (NE $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section Thirty-four (34), thence east 1183 feet, thence south to Cedar River, thence along the west bank of the Cedar River to a point 873 feet south of the section line, thence west to the quarter line, thence north 873 feet to the place of beginning; also commencing at the Southwest (SW) corner of the Southeast Quarter (SE $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section Twenty-seven (27), thence North 1154.5 feet, thence East 2640 feet to the section line, thence 837.5 feet South, thence West 1457 feet, thence South 527 feet to the section line, thence West 1183 feet to the place of beginning; also commencing at a point on the section line 527 feet North of the Southwest (SW) corner of the Southwest Quarter (SW $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section Twenty-six (26), thence East 330 feet, thence North 338 feet, thence East 990 feet to the one-eighth line, thence North 494.5 feet, thence West 1320 feet, thence South 927 feet to the place of beginning, all in Township One Hundred Three (103), Range Eighteen (18), Mower County, Minnesota.

The quantity of lands embraced therein is one hundred sixty (160) acres more or less.

The number of actual residents therein has been determined by census, taken not more than eight weeks prior to the presentation of this petition, to be (366) three hundred sixty-six.

The name of the proposed village is to be the "VILLAGE OF MAPLEVIEW".

On motion duly made by Commissioner Decker and seconded by Commissioner Austinson, the following resolution was unanimously adopted.

WHEREAS, a petition has been duly filed petitioning the County Board of Mower County, Minnesota, to call an election for the determination of the proposed incorporation of the "Village of Mapleville", the boundaries thereof being set forth in said petition,

Now, therefore, Be It Resolved:

1. That said petition be, and the same hereby is approved, and that an election be called as petitioned for therein.

2. That Raymond Hartley, W. H. Cooke and Andrew Carl Jensen, residents of the said territory, be, and the same hereby are, appointed inspectors, who shall act as Judges of the election and conduct the same.

3. That the time of said election shall be May 21, 1946, between the hours of 9:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m. on the said day, and the place of the election shall be in the "Mapleville Store" operated by Martin W. Reed in said Mapleville Addition, located in the Town of Lansing, Mower County, Minnesota, and being within the limits of the proposed Village.

4. That a notice setting forth the time and place of holding the election, signed on behalf of the County Board by the County Auditor, shall be posted as provided by law.
