

ORDINANCE NO. 151

AN ORDINANCE ANNEXING TO THE VILLAGE OF PINE ISLAND, all that tract or parcel of land lying and being in the County of Olmsted and State of Minnesota described as follows, to-wit: All that part of the northeast quarter (NE 1/4) of Section five (5) township one hundred eight (108) north of range fifteen (15) west, described as follows: Beginning at the northwest corner of said northeast quarter (NE 1/4) running thence west along the north line of said northeast quarter (NE 1/4) 623 feet for point of beginning, running thence east along the north line of said northeast quarter (NE 1/4) 167 feet, thence south 18 minutes east, 21 feet, thence west parallel with the north line of said northeast quarter (NE 1/4) 167 feet, thence north 18 minutes west, 21 feet to point of beginning; said described land to be known as the Hess Addition to the Village of Pine Island.

WHEREAS, the owners of all of the land hereinafter described have petitioned for annexation thereof to the Village of Pine Island, and it appears that the same adjoins and abuts the present limits of the Village of Pine Island:

THE VILLAGE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF PINE ISLAND DO ORDAIN:

Section 1. That the following described real estate being all that tract or parcel of land lying and being in the County of Olmsted and State of Minnesota described as follows, to-wit: All that part of the northeast quarter (NE 1/4) of Section five (5) township one hundred eight (108) north of range fifteen (15) west, described as follows: Beginning at the northwest corner of said northeast quarter (NE 1/4) running thence west along the north line of said northeast quarter (NE 1/4) 623 feet for point of beginning, running thence east along the north line of said northeast (NE 1/4) 167 feet, thence south 18 minutes east, 21 feet, thence west parallel with the north line of said northeast quarter (NE 1/4) 167 feet, thence north 18 minutes west, 21 feet to point of beginning; said described land to be known as the Hess Addition to the Village of Pine Island, being adjacent and abutting land is hereby annexed to and made a part of the Village of Pine Island.

Section 2. That this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and official publication.

Chester Barry being duly sworn, on oath says; that he is, and during all the times herein stated has been the publisher or printer of the newspaper known as the Pine Island Record, and has full knowledge of the facts hereinafter stated; that for more than one year prior to the publication therein of the Notice

That the notice

hereto attached was cut from the columns of said newspaper, and was printed and published therein in the English language, once each week, for two successive weeks, that it was first so published on Thursday, the 6th day of

June, 1946, and thereafter on Thursday of each week to and including the 10th day of June, 1946, and that the following is a printed copy of the lower case alphabet from A to Z, both inclusive, and is hereby acknowledged as being the size and kind of type used in the composition and publication of said notice, to-wit:
