

# STATUTORY REFERENCES TO ABOLISHED PERIODIC REPORTS TO THE LEGISLATURE

## A. Introduction

In 1994, the Legislature directed the Revisor of Statutes to make a list of periodic reports required by Minnesota Statute to be made to the Legislature. That list was compiled by our office in October, 1994. The complete 300 page Revisor's document listing and describing more than 700 such reports is available in the Legislative Reference Library. Since then the requirements for making some of the reports to the Legislature have been abolished (Some of the reports must still be made to non-legislative entities). The bulk of the abolition was done by Laws, 1995, chapter 248, article 1.

The list of statutory sections having report requirements that have been abolished follows this introduction. In cases in which some periodic report requirement in the section has also been retained, the subdivision or other unique description for the abolished report is provided. Remember that this list refers only to reports to the Legislature or its commissions, officials, or offices. If a report is also required to be made to non-legislative agencies, the presence of its statutory section number on this list does not change that requirement. Remember also that some statutory numbers have been changed since 1994. The 1994 numbers are on this list. The 1996 edition of Minnesota Statutes will indicate the new number after the 1994 number if there has been a change.

This list should be used in conjunction with the Revisor's October 1994 list of required periodic reports or with Minnesota Statutes to get particulars about the reports that no longer need to be made. Legislation to reflect, in statute, the abolition of the reporting requirements will be presented to the 1997 Legislature as part of a Revisor's Bill.
