Dear Members:

Pursuant to 2005 Minnesota Laws, Chapter 136, Article 17, Section 40, the Department of Public Safety shall annually report on the disposition of certain forfeiture proceeds from the trafficking of persons.

Specifically, the report must include the amount of money appropriated to the commissioner; how the money was distributed by the commissioner; and what the organizations that received the money did with it.

In 2005, no funds were received by the department for violations of sections 609.282, 609.283, or 609.322.

The department views this correspondence as satisfying the reporting requirements of 2005 Minnesota Laws, Chapter 136, Article 17, Section 40.
