This letter reports the progress of the \$18 million Red Lake capital loan as required in Laws 2005, Chapter 20, Article 1, Section 5.

On affirmation of project changes submitted and approved under Minnesota Statutes 16B.335, the Department of Education has completed the Capital Loan Construction Agreement for the Red Lake Capital Loan Project and provided the document to the school district. The Department and Red Lake representatives are currently discussing contract language and expect that agreement will be reached and the contract document fully executed by January 30.

The Red Lake School District anticipates soliciting construction bids in early March, 2006.
