Supplemental Nursing Services: A Report to the Minnesota Legislature 2005 and 2006

I. INTRODUCTION

Minnesota Statutes, Chapter 256B.039, requires the Commissioner of the Department of Human Services (DHS) to report annually to the legislature on the use of supplemental nursing services in nursing facilities, including the number of hours worked by supplemental nursing services agency (SNSA) personnel and payments to supplemental nursing services agencies. This report is intended to fulfill the requirement for March 2005 and March 2006.

For a description of the SNSA law, its history, intent and provisions, please see *Supplemental Nursing Services: A Report to the Minnesota Legislature* published on April 16, 2003 and *Supplemental Nursing Services 2003: A Report to the Minnesota Legislature* published in January, 2004.

II. Cost to Prepare

Minnesota Statutes 2006, Chapter 3.197 requires reports to the legislature to identify the cost of preparing the report. The cost for preparing this report was \$2,800.

III. SNSA Charge Limitation

Minnesota Statutes, Chapter 256B.039, limits SNSA charges to 150% of the weighted average cost of each position type in nursing facilities, by geographic group. The Department of Human Services is required to determine these charge limits, using data collected from nursing facilities, considering wages, benefits, associated costs and inflation. The department calculates separate limits for holidays and non-holidays.

Table 1 provides information on allowable maximum charges by SNSAs effective July 1, 2005 and July 1, 2006, and Table 2 lists the counties in each geographic group.

IV. Data Available

Data is provided for the twelve year period from 1994 thru 2005, the latest year for which this data is available at the time of this writing. Data is provided for each of the three geographic groups and for the positions RN, LPN and CNA (TMA and CNA are combined). Data for all years shown is for the 12-month period ending on 9/30 of that year, and filed with DHS during the following few months.

Including a year-by-year comparison of SNSA data is not possible for all facilities. Under Minnesota Statutes 256B.434 (commonly known as the Alternative Payment System (APS) statute), nursing facilities have been allowed to remove themselves from the Rule 50 method of rate setting since 1996. Before then, Rule 50 was the mechanism by which nursing facility rates were set and they were based on historical costs. When a facility moved to APS, during its initial years, it filed a "data collection report" rather than a Rule 50 cost report. The data collection report did not require a facility to report costs, only selected statistical data. Without the cost data, a trend analysis of all nursing facility expenses related to SNSA's cannot be produced. Starting in 2001 the data collection report did include costs for some positions, because the SNSA law required the department to use this information for setting charge limits and preparing this report. Therefore, the data for the years 1995 to 2000 does not include all facilities. However, while the number of facilities upon which this data is based varies from year to year, we have no reason to believe that this variation in the number of facilities introduces any significant bias to the overall trends. The number of facilities reporting is shown in Table 3. The total of statewide facilities reported in 2003 is fewer than the number of facilities in the state because Rule 50 hospital attached facilities are not required to provide this data.

V. Enforcement Activities

In FY 2005 and 2006 MDH conducted surveys of 53 SNSAs. At the time of this writing two enforcement actions are underway.

VI. Number of SNSA Agencies

As of April 23, 2007 there are 89 SNSAs registered with MDH.

VII. Comparing SNSA Costs per Hour with Employee Costs per Hour

Trend data for the cost per hour of SNSA workers and nursing home employees is provided in Table 4.

- In examining employee cost per hour figures, for the three geographic groups, the three positions and for changes from 2003 to 2004 and 2004 to 2005, of 18 comparisons, 1 showed a decrease, 2 were essentially level, and 15 increased. Six of the increases noted were greater than 10% over the prior year.
- In the metro geographic group, costs per hour in 2005 exceed the 2000-2001 levels for all three positions. In the non-metro geographic groups, costs per hour were less in 2005 than in 2000-2001 for most positions.
- The average hourly cost may have been influenced by a shift in the portion of SNSA hours used on holidays.

It should be noted that the weighted average wage rates used in Table 1 for determining the allowable maximum charges differ from costs per hour for employees shown in Table 4. This is because the limits in Tables 1 are adjusted upward to allow for the cost of payroll taxes.

VIII. SNSA Hours

Trend data for SNSA hours is provided in Table 5.

- SNSA hours per 100,000 total hours increased in geographic group I for all three positions in 2005 and for RNs and CNAs in 2004.
- In geographic group II and III and statewide hours either were level or decreased in 2004 and 2005.
- SNSA hours in 2004 were only 26% of their 2001 level and declined further in 2005 to 19% of their 2001 level.

IX. SNSA Costs

Trend data for SNSA costs is provided in Table 6.

- Total SNSA costs are generally down in geographic groups 2 and 3 and statewide for all three positions and up in geographic group 1 in 2005 after declining slightly in 2004.
- Statewide SNSA total costs for all three positions are down to \$11.3 million in 2004 and \$8.9 million in 2005, from \$20.7 million in 2002 and from \$42.7 million in 2001.
- The one area of concern would be geographic group I, where total SNSA costs increased in 2004 and again in 2005.

 Table 7 shows the cost per resident day of SNSA use. The statewide cost, spread over all facilities declined from \$1.04 in 2004 to \$0.88 on 2005. The cost per resident day spread only over facilities that reported SNSA use declined by only 7 cents, while actually increasing by \$0.56 in geographic group I and \$0.08 in geographic group II.

X. Nursing Home Report Card

The Minnesota Nursing Home Report Card went live on the MDH web site at <u>www.health.state.mn.us/nhreportcard/</u> on January 20, 2006. One of the quality measures in the report card reports on SNSA use by nursing facilities. Table 8 shows the thresholds for awarding between one and five stars and the number of facilities at each level in 2004 and 2005. The number of facilities reporting no SNSA use grew from 252 in 2004, 61.6% of nursing facilities, to 268 in 2005, 67.0%.

XI. Conclusions

While the effect of the SNSA law on actual charges has been relatively small, the effect on utilization of SNSA has been dramatic. In addition, the low level of enforcement activity suggests that the law has been effective at regulating a variety of business practices that were perceived as problematic in the period prior to enactment of the SNSA law.




Actual Costs of Supplemental Nursing Services Semi-rural (group two) Facilities Table 6 (continued)




Actual Costs of Supplemental Nursing Services Metro (group three) Facilities




Actual Costs of Supplemental Nursing Services All Facilities (statewide)


Statewide Total SNSA Costs


